**Vets Ride with Pride qualifications*:
VA service-connected veterans (including 0%)
Veterans in receipt of VA Pension**

Those eligible for Vets Ride with Pride will be able to receive a “Commute Card” from the Dane County Veterans Service Office (CVSO) at 210 Martin Luther King Jr Blvd - Room 108 that will work for all fixed-route services offered by Madison Metro. Office hours are from Monday – Friday, 7:45AM – 4:30PM. For questions please call (608) 266-4158.



* Officially, it will be the responsibility of the veteran to furnish evidence showing **Vets Ride with Pride** eligibility; however, the CVSO will do what it can to assist with proving program eligibility. Eligible veterans can present their VA Veterans Identification Card (VIC) at the CVSO office showing service-connection or other proof showing they are in receipt of compensation or pension. Items may include bank statements showing direct deposit from the VA, VA award letters, letters from eBenefits, as well as other VA documentation. In many, **but not all cases**, we will have the necessary proof required at our office to prove veterans eligibility for Vets Ride with Pride.
