



Vets Ride with Pride qualifications*: VA service-connected veterans (including 0%) Veterans in receipt of VA Pension



Dane County proudly offers free FastFare passes to qualified veterans. Veterans eligible for Vets Ride with Pride are able to receive FastFare passes from the Dane County Veterans Service Office (CVSO). Passes are good for all fixed-route and Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) routes offered by Madison Metro.

^{*} Officially, it is the responsibility of the veteran to furnish evidence showing Vets Ride with Pride eligibility; however, the CVSO will do what it can to assist. Eligible veterans can present their VA Veterans Health Identification Card (VHIC) at the CVSO office showing service-connection or other proof showing they are in receipt of compensation or pension. Items may include bank statements showing direct deposit from the VA, VA award letters, letters from VA.GOV, as well as other VA documentation. From time to time, the CVSO will already have the necessary proof required to help establish eligibility for Vets Ride with Pride.
